



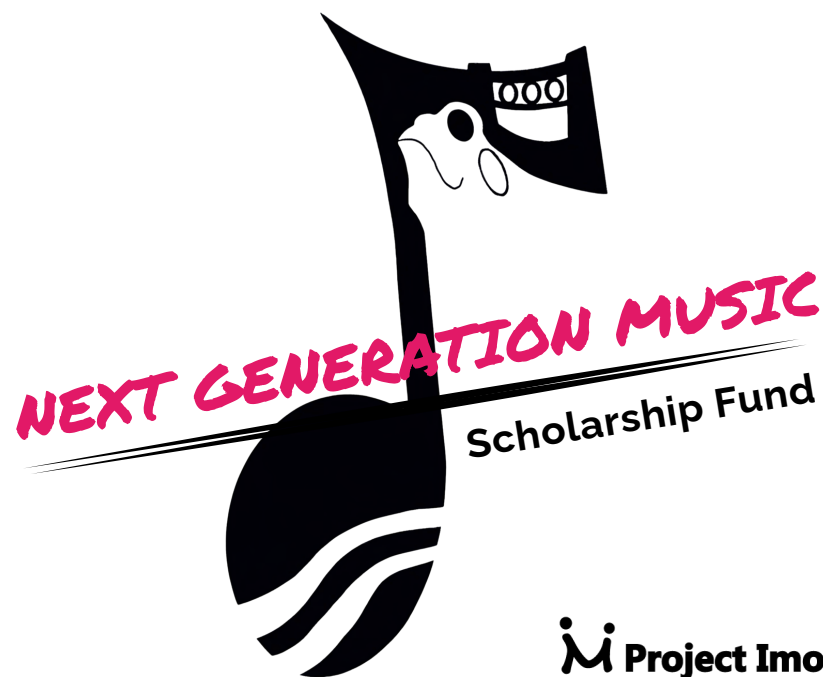

Across Eastern Connecticut, young people with a passion for music face persistent barriers like, no access to instruments, limited ability to afford lessons or camps, and lack of mentorship or creative spaces

Traditional arts funding often supports established artists, while younger musicians are expected to already have access, training, and resources.

The result: talent is lost before it ever has a chance to develop.
